

Expert insights: How industry ICT leaders are shaping education at UM



For the past eight years, the [Department of Computer Science](#) has been offering a selection of technical study-units within the [Programme in the Liberal Arts and Sciences](#) (PLAS).

The rationale behind these study-units is twofold:

1. They aim to meet the demand for ICT professionals seeking to enhance their academic background by providing specialised knowledge in current and emerging software technologies and tools.
2. Specific study-units are intentionally crafted to introduce non-ICT professionals to specific areas within the field of ICT.

The areas covered include single page application development, software testing, audio engineering, cybersecurity, programming in Java and Python, data science and blockchain. More units are in the pipeline for future years focusing on Kotlin and software test automation for complete beginners. The study-units demonstrated success, garnering widespread positive feedback from participants:
