

The Office of the Registrar issues Digital Credentials to all graduands



The <u>Office of the Registrar</u> strives to innovate on the current available technology to provide a better service to students and staff.

In collaboration with the <u>European University of the Seas</u> and <u>Europass</u>, the Office of the Registrar embarked on a new project to provide <u>European Digital Credentials for Learning</u> to all UM graduands from 2021 onwards. These credentials include a digital version of the scroll that is signed with a unique electronic seal (that is the digital equivalent of an institution's rubber stamp). This allows potential employers, education and training institutions to easily authenticate, validate and recognise credentials of any size, shape or form.

Following the graduation ceremonies held in November and December 2021, all graduands received their qualifications in digital format in addition to the physical Latin Scroll and <u>Europass Diploma</u> <u>Supplement</u>. This procedure will be adopted by the Office of the Registrar to issue digital credentials to all its future graduands.
