

Recognition of CLS work with Eurofound



The <u>Centre for Labour Studies</u> (CLS) is Malta's contact centre for the **European Foundation for the Improvement of Living and Working Conditions**. The Foundation is a tripartite European Union Agency, whose role is to provide information, advice and expertise on working conditions and sustainable work, industrial relations, labour market change, quality of life, and public services. It supports the EU institutions and bodies, member states and social partners in shaping and implementing social and employment policies, as well as promoting social dialogue on the basis of comparative information, research and analysis.

The CLS has been contributing research and reports to the Foundation since 2003, by winning five back-to-back contracts. The sterling work of the CLS has been recently recognised in a quality audit exercise in which the Centre received the third highest rating of all EU-28 countries plus Norway. The audit investigated content quality, balance in reporting, style and presentation, command of English, and timeliness of delivery. The work of the CLS is promoted internationally through the Foundation's <u>website</u>.
