



When the fabric has cooled down, the fusing process will be complete. Then pin the pattern back on the fabric and transfer the pattern markings as required.

Place a steam iron, on a steam setting, on top of the pressing cloth.	
Place fabric on pressing surface, wrong side up, making sure it is straight and not wrinkled.	1
Cover with a dry pressing cloth and spray the cloth with a fine mist of water.	
Leave the iron in place for at least 10 seconds before moving it to the next area of fabric.	
Check to see if the interfacing is fused to the fabric by rolling the fabric. If the interfacing is still loose in places, repeat the pressing process.	




This is a common figure type for women and features hips and thighs which are broader (wider) in comparison to the rest of the body. Being bottom heavy makes the figure look shorter.
