




Figure 1 The world's major plate boundaries. Source: https://www.thoughtco.com/map-of-tectonic-plates-and-their-boundaries-1441098




Fig. 1 Well-known buildings in Malta.




Fig. 2 Sketch plan of the Grand Harbour and Marsamxett Harbour areas.




Fig. 3 Illustration of items of Maltese vernacular architecture.




Fig. 4 Different weather instruments.




Fig. 5 Different Maltese habitats.




Fig. 6 Different family units.
