To the Head of School,

It would be appreciated if the following communication could be passed on to teachers teaching SEC Art candidates and to the candidates themselves.

As in previous years, with respect to SEC Art, candidates are provided with an A3 paper. Candidates may bring their own blank paper if they wish. If they opt to do so, it should have the same dimensions as the paper provided (A3) and should be brought in as supplied by the manufacturer and not tampered with in any way. Candidates need to ask the invigilator to sign this sheet at the back before they start their work.

If paint is used, it must be quick drying. Pastel, chalk and charcoal must be fixed.

The exam is three hours long. One hour is allotted for preparatory work and two hours are allotted for the final work. However, candidates may organise the three hour exam in the way they deem fit. Therefore, for instance, candidates may choose to spend less than an hour on their preparatory work and more time on their final work. The work must be handed in to the invigilator completely dry at the end of the three hours.
